Executive Summary


Primary School Program

The 2023/24 year saw significant advancements in our Interactive Storytelling Program, which has continued to enhance interactive games designed to engage young minds. This year, we expanded our Reading Marathon Classes, known as Junior Bear, specifically to support students with lower English proficiency, providing them with tailored resources to boost their literacy skills.

Additionally, we are pleased to report the successful expansion of our **Listening Enhancement Program** to a new partner school, allowing us to reach and benefit even more students. This year, we expanded our reach to include undergraduate students from Education University, enriching their preparation for the classroom's demands and joys.


We are committed to offering valuable opportunities for aspiring educators and eagerly anticipate the journey ahead.


